

## Q Do we need an emergency beacon for Spain?

Having just returned from a few weeks in Spain, there was quite a bit of conversation between motorhome owners about new regulations coming in Spain and France, regarding red warning triangles and beacons. Doing a bit of research on Google, things seem to add up so I'm wondering if you could clarify the regulations.

Do we still need two triangles? Do they have to have LED lights? Do we need beacons? Do the beacons need to have GPS transmitters?

I do hope you can help resolve this and put the news out so vehicle drivers don't end up on the wrong side of the law.

**CLIVE MOTT** There are many of us, including ourselves, who visit Spain regularly, so this is certainly a topic we need to be aware of. There are several facets associated with this and some have already taken place.

From 1 July 2023, in Spain the use of warning triangles on motorways is not required in the event of immobilisation of the vehicle due to an incident or breakdown. The DGT (Spanish Traffic Authority) is phasing out the triangles because placing them on a busy highway isn't ideal from a safety point of view.

In Spain, the standard for breakdown warning devices is transitioning from traditional red warning triangles to the connected V-16 flashing warning light, with the triangles becoming obsolete from 1 January, 2026. These battery-powered flashing red lights have an internal GPS and conform to a standard known as V-16. They are normally equipped with a magnetic base so they can be attached to the roof of a car without the driver actually getting out, Kojak style!

Until 31 December 2025, you can still use either traditional red warning triangles or the new V-16 flashing lights, but the DGT recommends purchasing the 'connected' version of the V-16 now, as they will be the only type permitted by law in the future.

The V-16 signal is an emergency signalling device that will alert other drivers to an incident on the road. The V-16 is connected to the DGT, allowing the broken-down

vehicle to be geolocated and an alert to be sent to other drivers.

When the button is pressed, the V-16 activates and emits a high-intensity flashing light. The device connects to the DGT platform and transmits its location in real time, once every 100 seconds.

Drivers in the area will receive an alert on their connected devices informing them of the incident.

Since the connectivity of the V-16 lights only applies in Spanish territory, their effectiveness abroad will be solely visual.

Additionally, most drivers, and even police officers in other European countries, are not familiar with the V-16 light signal, as it is a recent creation in Spain and may not yet be recognised.

However, not even Kojak's arm is long enough to place a V-16 on top of a motorhome and the magnetic mounting will not work on an aluminium or GRP body.

It seems that alternative ways of attaching your V-16 are needed. The standard specifies that there are V-16 lights on the market with a magnetised base that facilitate their attachment to non-horizontal metal surfaces of vehicles whose height does not allow them to be placed on the roof, thus ensuring maximum visibility.

There are also beacons that can be attached to non-metallic surfaces by means of suction cups or similar fittings.

Most V-16 devices can be charged up via a USB connector from the host vehicle, so they are always ready for use.

**ED** We asked the DGT for further clarification as there is differing information on the internet about how these new rules apply to motorhomes.

It said, "Spain is the first country to make this illuminated and connected device mandatory starting 1 January 2026.

"The Vienna Convention establishes that countries may require, in order to permit 'international circulation' within their territory, that the vehicle be equipped with a signalling device consisting of 'a plate in the form of an equilateral triangle' or 'any other

device of equal effectiveness prescribed by the legislation of the country in which the vehicle is registered'. Vehicles registered in other countries that circulate in Spain as 'international traffic' will be complying with the regulations if they use triangles.

"Vehicles registered in Spain for 'international circulation' through another country that is a signatory to any of the current conventions will comply with the regulations by using the new illuminated V-16 hazard warning device, without the need to be equipped with warning triangles."

So, UK-registered motorhomes will be legal if they carry a warning triangle, while Spanish-registered motorhomes will need to use the new V-16 warning device from 1 January 2026. Clive later added that he had bought a standard non-connected flashing beacon, as it's a lot safer than hiking back down the autoroute with a triangle.



## PURCHASING YOUR V16 BEACON...

You can purchase these V16 beacons from many suppliers, Aliexpress for £6.50, EBay for £10.99, Amazon for £14.50, some outfit called Motardinn for £34.50, so be careful where and who you buy from as there is a large difference in prices.

Doing a small internet search it seems this rule will come into effect on 1 st January 2026 for Spanish vehicles only, with no date set for the rest of Europe to follow, but we all know how tricky some forces can interpret new laws, so I have bought mine just in case and it will sit next to my Hi-Viz jacket and the French Breathalyser kit we needed to buy and have never used.



# WINTERIZING YOUR RV CHECKLIST

## Step 1: Draining Your RV

- Remove and bypass any inline water filters.
- Drain fresh water, black and gray holding tanks.
- Flush black and gray holding tanks with built-in flushing system or use a cleaning wand. Lubricate termination valves with WD 40.
- Drain water heater by removing the drain plug and opening the pressure relief valve. **NEVER drain water heater when it's hot or pressurized.**
- Open all hot and cold faucets (don't forget outside shower and toilet valve!)
- Open low point drain lines
- Close all faucets and recap all drains.

### supplies

- water heater by-pass kit**
- holding tank cleaning wand**
- water pump converter kit**
- RV antifreeze (2-3 gallons)**
- wrench to remove drain plugs**

## Step 2: Winterizing with Antifreeze

- Bypass the water heater.
- Install a water pump converter kit or disconnect the inlet side of the water pump.
- Connect tubing from the water pump inlet into a 1-gallon container of antifreeze.
- Turn on the water pump and allow system to pressurize. Starting with the closest faucet, gradually open hot and then cold valves until antifreeze trickles out. Replace the antifreeze jug as required.  
Repeat this step on all faucets from the closest to the farthest away.
- Flush the toilet until antifreeze appears in the bowl.
- Turn off the water pump and open a faucet to depressurize.
- Pour a cupful of antifreeze down each drain and a couple of cups in the toilet bowl and flush into the holding tank.

## Step 3: Preparing for Storage


- Make sure any electric heating elements are turned off.
- Double check that all faucets are closed.

## 2026 TRIP TO CROATIA


Hi Campers... We are being ambitious this coming year 2026 with a trip to Croatia. Some of our members have used this site many times and have given us some great information in organizing this club trip, our thanks to Chris and Roger . Our plan is to set off straight after the Warner's Show at Newbury; arriving at Dover on Tuesday 19th May 2026 for a 06.00 morning ferry to Dunkirk (sorry it is a little early) it has to be an early start to get us hopefully to our first fuel stop at Luxembourg for cheaper fuel, this will be a wild camping night. The trip from Dunkirk to Pula looks like 962 miles making it 14 hour total journey. We are looking to do this in two long days of driving most of this will be motorway and some road tolls will need to be added to your trip.

Now as always you can leave the UK when you want and join up with the club in Croatia, you can also take your time in going to Croatia and meet up with us later, we will just need to know your arrival time to make sure there is a pitch available for you.

Costing so far using DFDS ferries is estimated for a large motor home on an economy tariff to be £385.00 to £400.00 return with a returning date in June. If you use flexi rates the price will increase but this will allow you to return to the UK when you like if there is room on board. 
